

SJ to visit London

The Secretary for Justice, Mr Wong Yan Lung, SC, will leave for London for a five-day visit on Monday (June 5).

During the visit, Mr Wong will call on the Attorney General for England and Wales, Lord Goldsmith, QC; the Secretary of State for Constitutional Affairs, Rt Hon Lord Falconer of Thoroton; the Chairman of the Foreign Affairs Committee, Mr Mike Gapes; the former Deputy Prime Minister, Lord Howe; and the Chinese Ambassador to the United Kingdom, Mr Zha Peixin.
