

SJ to attend Kunming conference

The Secretary for Justice, Ms Elsie Leung, and the Director of Public Prosecutions, Mr Grenville Cross, SC, will attend the China-ASEAN Prosecutors General Conference in Kunming, Yunnan, from July 8 to 9.

Hosted by the Supreme People's Prosecution Service of the People's Republic of China, the theme of the conference is "Maintaining Regional Stability, Combating Transnational Crime".

While in Kunming, Ms Leung will meet with the Supreme People's Procuratorate Procurator-General, Mr Jia Chunwang, and senior officials of Yunnan Province.

Mr Cross will also deliver a speech entitled "Towards a Modern Prosecuting Authority: Challenges and Opportunities" on Friday (July 9).
