

The Law of the People's Republic of China on Safeguarding National Security in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (National Security Law) was promulgated and took effect on 30 June 2020. Aiming to enhance understanding and awareness of the National Security Law, the Department of Justice of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region is organising a Legal Forum, bringing together legal experts to discuss and exchange views on the application and interpretation of the National Security Law. This Legal Forum comprises a series of keynote speeches given by distinguished speakers as well as three panel discussions where legal experts will examine the substantive and procedural aspects of the National Security Law and deliver a comparative study of national security laws of other jurisdictions.
