The HCCH Secondment Programme

- Secondment of Hong Kong legal professionals to the Permanent Bureau of the HCCH in The Hague, the Netherlands
- Secondment period: Normally 6 to 12 months unless agreed otherwise
- ► The Permanent Bureau of the HCCH is headed by its Secretary General Dr. Christophe Bernasconi, and supported by a team of diplomatic lawyers
- ► The HCCH is a global inter-governmental organisation working for the progressive unification of the private international law rules
- ► The HCCH develops and services multilateral legal instruments in a wide range of areas

The HCCH Secondment Programme Who can apply?

- Open to <u>both</u> private legal practitioners in Hong Kong and lawyers from the public sector
 - ▶ Private sector secondee: monthly allowance of HK\$50,000 from the HCCH
 - Civil servants in the employ of the Government: subject to the secondment terms under the relevant Government regulations

The HCCH Secondment Programme How to apply?

- ► Application deadline: 18 February 2021
- Non-Government applicants
 - ▶ Application form and supporting documents (including CV, written submission, two or more letters of recommendation, previous written work, transcripts and employment records, etc.)
 - "Secondment Programmes to International Organisations" webpage (https://www.doj.gov.hk/en/miscellaneous/secondment_programmes_to_international_organisations.html)
- Government applicants
 - Relevant information and application forms circulated to the legal divisions in DoJ, as well as the relevant law-related departments

The HCCH Secondment Programme Selection Criteria

- (a) be permanent residents of the HKSAR with Chinese nationality;
- (b) be (i) solicitors admitted in Hong Kong; (ii) barristers with the right to full practice in Hong Kong; or (iii) civil servants who are serving at the ranks of the grades as specified in the advertisement circulated to the relevant law-related departments;
- (c) have received law school education in a system based on civil law, common law and equity, or other, including conflicts of laws and are familiar with comparative law (substantive and procedural law); knowledge of public international law, particularly the law of treaties, is desirable;
- (d) have a good command, both written and spoken, of at least one of the official languages of the HCCH (French or English); knowledge of another language is an asset; and
- (e) have good drafting capabilities (dissertation, academic essay, law review or other publication experience will be taken into account).
