

## **WINNIE TAM SC**

Winnie is a barrister-at-law, arbitrator and mediator in independent private practice in Hong Kong. Her practice areas include civil and commercial law with an emphasis on intellectual property. She was admitted to practise as a barrister in England and Wales in 1988, and remains to date an overseas member of IP specialist chambers at 8 New Square, London. She was also admitted as an advocate and solicitor in Singapore and the Australian Capital Territory. Winnie is a panel arbitrator of the HKIAC's Intellectual Property Specialist Panel, a member of the Expert Committee of the Hi-tech and IP Arbitration Committee of the South China International Arbitration Commission (SCIA), a panel arbitrator of SCIA, and a fellow of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators and a CEDR-accredited mediator.

Winnie was awarded the title of Senior Counsel by the Chief Justice of HKSAR in 2006. In 2015, she was appointed as a Recorder of the Court of First Instance, High Court of the Hong Kong SAR.

She was elected to serve as the Chairman of the Hong Kong Bar Association between January 2015 to January 2017 and in that capacity spearheaded a number of significant reforms. Since January 2017, she has continued to serve the Bar by heading its two practice development committees.
