Ir Prof Lau is a renowned civil engineer and has over 40 years of experience in planning, design, construction and maintenance of infrastructures in Hong Kong and Mainland China. The most notable projects are the three world class cable supported bridges, namely Tsing Ma Bridge, Kap Shiu Mun Bridge and Ting Kau Bridge. As the former Director of Civil Engineering, he was responsible for the Hong Kong Disneyland Theme Park among other civil engineering works.

He was elected as the President of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (HKIE) in 2002/03.

Since joining AECOM Asia Co. Ltd, he has been active in promoting Hong Kong experience into Mainland China. Major projects include Sutong Bridge, the world's second longest cable stayed bridge, as well as Shanghai Chongming bridge/tunnel, Shanghai Bund tunnel and HK/Zhuhai/Macau bridge etc.

Over the years, Ir Prof Lau has been involved in many mediation/adjudication/arbitration cases in the construction industry.
