

Moderator's Title: Prof. LEUNG Hing Fung

Profile: Prof. LEUNG Hing Fung is the Chairperson of Hong Kong Mediation Council, Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC). He is an Associate Professor in the Department of Real Estate and Construction, Faculty of Architecture, University of Hong Kong, with specialty in property and construction law and dispute resolution.

Prof. Leung is a member of various panels and lists of mediators including the Panel of General Accredited Mediators of the Hong Kong Mediation Accreditation Association Limited (HKMAAL), the Panel of General Accredited Mediators of HKIAC, the Joint Panel of Accredited Mediators of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors and Hong Kong Institute of Architects, the List of Mediators of the Hong Kong Bar Association, the Panel of Mediators of the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators and the Panel of Mediators of The International Commercial Mediation Joint Court in Shanghai. Since 2003, Prof. Leung has acted as mediator in many cases with disputes of various kinds from small work place disputes to huge land, construction and financial disputes. Prof. Leung has been very active in training and assessment of mediation. He frequently acts as lead assessor in Stage II mediation assessments for HKIAC, HKMAAL and the Law Society of Hong Kong. He was the lead assessor for the first HKIAC Stage II assessment held in China.

Besides practising mediation and training, Prof. Leung has been very active in public services. He is a member of the Steering Committee on Mediation chaired by the Secretary for Justice formed in 2012. He is at present a Chairman of the Appeal Tribunal under the Buildings Ordinance, a member of the Town Planning Board and a member of the Railway Objections Hearing Panel.

Prof. Leung is a frequent speaker and writer on topics related to mediation and other forms of dispute resolution.
