

Short bibliography of Prof. Paul B. S. Lai



Prof. Paul B. S. Lai graduated from the Chinese University of Hong Kong. He received his training as a specialist general surgeon in Hong Kong and Edinburgh. He is currently the Chairman and Honorary Chief of Service of the Department of Surgery at the Prince of Wales Hospital, the Chinese University of Hong Kong. Prof. Lai is an active researcher in basic and clinical research in hepato-biliary and pancreatic surgery, especially in the field of liver cancer.

On the administration side, Prof. Lai is the Cluster Coordinator for Surgical Services at the New Territories East Cluster of the Hospital Authority and the Assistant Dean for the Faculty of Medicine of CUHK. He is currently the Censor-in-chief of the College of Surgeons of Hong Kong. He is also the Chief Editor of the College's official journal – *Surgical Practice*.

Prof. Lai also serves in the steering committee of the Surgical Outcome Monitoring and Improvement Program (or abbreviated as SOMIP) in the Hospital Authority. Prof. Lai is currently the director for the Wong Tze Lam – Hing Tak Centre of Surgical Outcome Research at CUHK and he has also launched full-coverage of surgical outcome audit at the Department of Surgery at Prince of Wales Hospital.

He was conferred master of medical law by the University of Northumbria and received his training in mediation at the Hong Kong Mediation Center. Prof. Lai is an active trainer and facilitator in various courses and forums related to medical law and mediation for healthcare professionals; both in the Faculty of Medicine, the Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Hospital Authority.
