He is also involved in a number of arbitration and mediation organizations in China and overseas; Panel of Mediators of HKIAC, HKMC, HKMAAL, HKICM, Assessors of HKMC and HKMAAL, Panel of Arbitrators of HKIAC, CIETAC, BAC, WAC, GAC, SAC etc.

Dr Leung is also a qualified engineer of FICE, FASCE, FHKIE, PEng, RPE, FHKICM, FHKIArb, and SMIEEE, with a Master's degree in Construction Management from the University of Toronto, Canada and a PhD in Information Engineering from the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
