Amarantha is the Head of Service of the Hong Kong Family Welfare Society overseeing the Mediation Service, Divorce Service and Children & Youth Service.

Amarantha has extensive experience in Family Mediation Service, Mediation Training and Mediation Education. She has been involved as a trainer / coach for numerous mediation training programmes run by different professional organisations, training and education institutes. Target groups include officials of the Ombudsmen, Home Affairs Bureau, Hong Kong Police Force, Correction Services Department, legal professionals, social workers, medical professionals, school principals, teaching professionals and university students, etc. She introduced Peer Mediation in Hong Kong in 2001 and has launched mediation education in schools and the community to promote the use of mediation in resolve disputes among students and the general public.

Amarantha is active in the development of Mediation in Hong Kong. She served on the Judiciary's Steering Committee on Family Mediation to pilot and steer the development of this service in 1999-2012.
