活動簡介 Synopsis:

隨着啟德體育園以及體育爭議解決先導計劃(「先導計劃」)運作日漸成熟，香港的體育生態發展現正邁入嶄新的篇章。作為《施政報告》其中一項措施，先導計劃由律政司推出，文化體育及旅遊局支持，旨在為體育界提供一個公平、高效及便捷的制度，透過調解及仲裁解決體育糾紛。

隨着體育產業蓬勃發展，相關爭議的數量及複雜程度預計將持續上升，涵蓋合約及商業事宜，以至比賽相關的各種問題。鑑於賽程緊密及運動員職業生涯相對短暫，具效率且及時的解決爭議機制至關重要。調解以其靈活性、保密性及重視關係維繫的特點，為體育爭議提供具建設性的解決方法。

本研討會將探討調解在香港體育生態中日益重要的角色，並分享以調解為核心的先導計劃所得的經驗，探討此模式如何推動香港體育產業的可持續發展，以及促進香港成為國際體育爭議解決中心。

Hong Kong's sports landscape is entering an exciting chapter, marked by the growing utilisation of the Kai Tak Sports Park and the Pilot Scheme on Sports Dispute Resolution ("Pilot Scheme"). The Pilot Scheme, launched by the Department of Justice with the support of the Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau as one of the initiatives under the Policy Address, provides the sports sector with a fair, efficient and convenient mechanism for resolving sports disputes through mediation and arbitration.

As the sports industry continues to expand, the volume and complexity of disputes—ranging from contractual and commercial matters to competition-related issues—are expected to increase. Given the demanding competition schedules and athletes' relatively short career spans, efficient and timely resolution mechanisms are crucial. Mediation, being flexible, confidential and relationship-focused, offers a constructive means of resolving sports disputes.

This seminar will explore the expanding role of mediation in Hong Kong's sports ecosystem, share insights from the Pilot Scheme which places mediation at its core, and consider how this approach can contribute to the sustainable development of Hong Kong's sports industry and promoting Hong Kong as an international centre for sports dispute resolution.
