

Iu Ting Kwok, also known as TK, is one of the busiest mediators in Hong Kong and has mediated more than 450 cases since April 2010. He has the ability to handle difficult, complicated, multi-party and highly emotional disputes.

TK is a lead trainer in HKMAAL accredited mediation courses. Academically, he is an:-

- (1) Adjunct Associate Professor, Department of Law, University of Hong Kong;
- (2) Adjunct Professor, School of Law, City University of Hong Kong; and
- (3) Adjunct Professor, Department of Law and Business, Hong Kong Shue Yan University.

TK speaks at various local and international mediation seminars and workshops.

He is the author of Chapter 4 – "What are the legal concerns when mediating internationally?" of Asia Mediation Handbook, Sweet & Maxwell (2015).

Between 2012 and 2016, TK was a member of the working group on the proposed Apology Legislation which is in the process of enactment. The Secretary of Justice has recently appointed TK to be a member of the Steering Committee on Mediation and the Chairman of the Special Committee on Evaluative Mediation. He sits on the Mediation Accreditation Committee of HKMAAL.

TK holds a master degree (with credit) in Arbitration and Dispute Resolution. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. He is a panel mediator of the Singapore International Mediation Centre.

He has been named as "one of the world's leading commercial mediators" by Who's Who Legal: Mediation 2015, 2016 and 2017.
